## **PMC Appeal Form**

## **Procedures**

Should a student not agree with the decision of the Professional Misconduct Committee (PMC), the student has the right to appeal to an Appeal Officer (Associate Dean or appointed designee). However, appeals must be submitted to the Office of Student Affairs (pmc@usa.edu) within 5 business days from the date of the Outcome of PMC Hearing letter AND meet one of the three criteria listed below. Student appeals should include a personal narrative outlining the grounds for the appeal and provide available supporting documentation. Upon receipt of this form and supporting documentation, the Office of Student Affairs will collect any additional documentation and forward a complete file to the with the decision of the Professional Misconduct Committee (PMC), the student has the right to appeal to an Appeal Officer. Upon receiving the request, the Appeal Officer will review all records contained in the file, including a review of the PMC process to ensure that it was correctly followed, and may meet with the PMC and/or the student if needed.

## **Final Decision of Appeal Officer**

If the final decision by the Appeal Officer results in a dismissal, the student will no longer be permitted to remain in any course. Once a final appeal decision has been rendered by the Appeal Officer, the student does not have access to the appeal process for the same issue again.

## **Statement of Understanding**

I understand that the Appeal Officer or appointed designee may:

- Deny my request for an appeal in which case the PMC decision will stand.
- Uphold, reverse, or modify the PMC decision.

I further understand that any decision made by the Appeal Officer regarding this appeal is final, and I will be informed of the decision in writing via my usa.edu email address.
